### Introduction

Thank you for purchasing a MacWireless Bluetooth Optical Mouse. Please note that the mouse requires an external Bluetooth USB Adapter, such as the MacWireless Bluetooth USB Adapter. We recommend updating your operating system to the latest version before proceeding with the configuration process. Free updates are available using Apple menu > Software Update and at [www.apple.com](http://www.apple.com).

### Installation

1. Open the battery compartment:
  - a. Pull the small latch on the bottom of the mouse.
  - b. Slide the main black portion of the top of the mouse away from the buttons.
2. Install the batteries in the orientation indicated by the battery slots.
3. Close the battery compartment.

### Configuration

#### OS 10.2.x / 10.3.x

1. Go to Apple Menu > System Preferences > Bluetooth > Devices Tab and choose "Set Up New Device."
2. If Bluetooth is not turned on, you will be prompted to turn it on. You will need to turn Bluetooth on to complete this installation.
3. The Bluetooth Setup Assistant will start. Click continue.
4. Choose "Any Device" or "Other Device." Click continue.
5. The Bluetooth Mouse will appear in the Bluetooth Setup Assistant. If the mouse does not appear on the list, push the white button on the underside of the mouse.
6. Highlight the Bluetooth Mouse option by clicking on it once, then click continue.
7. You will be prompted for the passkey. Enter four zeros (0000) and click continue. The computer will pair with your mouse.
8. The installation is complete. You can choose to set up another device or click quit to exit.

#### OS 10.4.x / 10.5.x

1. Go to Apple Menu > System Preferences > Bluetooth > Devices Tab and choose "Set Up New Device."
2. If Bluetooth is not turned on, you will be prompted to turn it on. You will need to turn Bluetooth on to complete this installation.
3. The Bluetooth Setup Assistant will start. Click continue.
4. Choose "Any Device" or "Other Device." Click continue.
5. The Bluetooth Mouse will appear in the Bluetooth Setup Assistant. If the mouse does not appear on the list, push the white button on the underside of the mouse.
6. Once the Bluetooth Mouse has appeared in the assistant, highlight it by clicking on it once.
7. Click the "Passkey Options..." button, choose "Use a Specific Passkey," click OK, and then click continue.
8. The Setup Assistant will gather information about the headset. When it is finished, click continue.
9. You will be prompted for the passkey. Enter four zeros (0000) and click continue. The computer will pair with your mouse.
10. When the pairing is complete, click continue.
11. The installation is finished. You can choose to set up another device or click quit to exit.

You can change settings for the mouse in System Preferences > Keyboard & Mouse. For more information about Bluetooth, choose Help and type "Bluetooth Help" in the search bar.

## Known Issues

**Issue:** MacWireless Bluetooth Mouse gets disconnected after computer goes to sleep when using Apple's built-in Bluetooth.

**Description:** Apple's Built-in Bluetooth module and MacWireless' Bluetooth Mouse are not fully compatible in that the Bluetooth connection is not automatically re-established upon waking the computer.

**Solution:** Re-pair with the mouse from the Bluetooth menu or using Bluetooth Setup Assistant. Alternately you can use MacWireless' USB Bluetooth Adapter with the Bluetooth Mouse to avoid this issue altogether.
